FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTS

February was the second month of strong rebound observed since the beginning of the year. Over the month, the World Index MSCI in euro (MSERWI) rose by 3.62%, against -0.08% for the bond index in euro uncovered (LBEATREU) over the same period. Quarterly business results, hopes of a trade deal between the United States and China, the meeting between President Donald Trump and his North Korean counterpart Kim Jong-un, and the unlikely outcome of a Brexit without agreement have blown a positive wind on the markets. In addition, the "dovish" tone of central banks, which lowered their expectations for the normalization of monetary policy, added stability to short and medium term forecasts. This can be observed on the Fed's yield curve since it took a strange path, slightly reversed up to 5 years and steeper beyond. However, many uncertainties and tensions are still present on the markets. In Europe, Brexit still weighs on investors. Germany continues to slow down, especially because of its exports. In the world, tensions between the United States and China are blocking all enthusiasm for the moment. The watchword is therefore to remain cautious, to take advantage of the great opportunities offered by the current market, while maintaining a defensive bias in the event of a turnaround. Over the month of February, the US dollar appreciated by 0.59% against the euro. The 10-year yield in the United States rose to 2.715% against a rise to 0.183% in Europe. During the month of February, the Archea Spectrum fund rose by 1.38% for a performance of 4.97% since the beginning of the year.

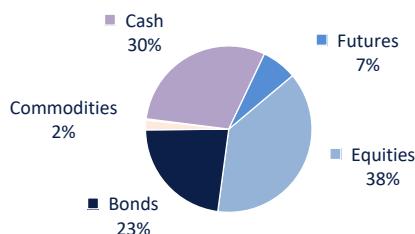
PERFORMANCE (from January 2008, data simulated)



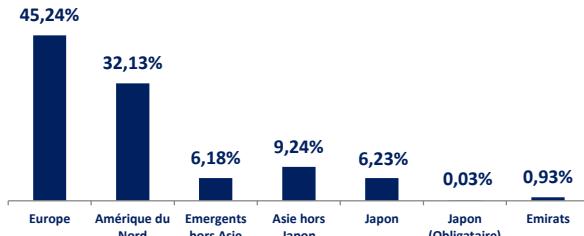

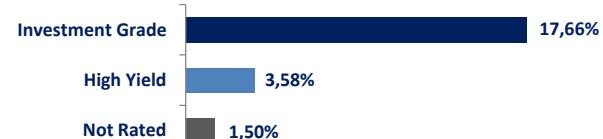
ASSET ALLOCATION



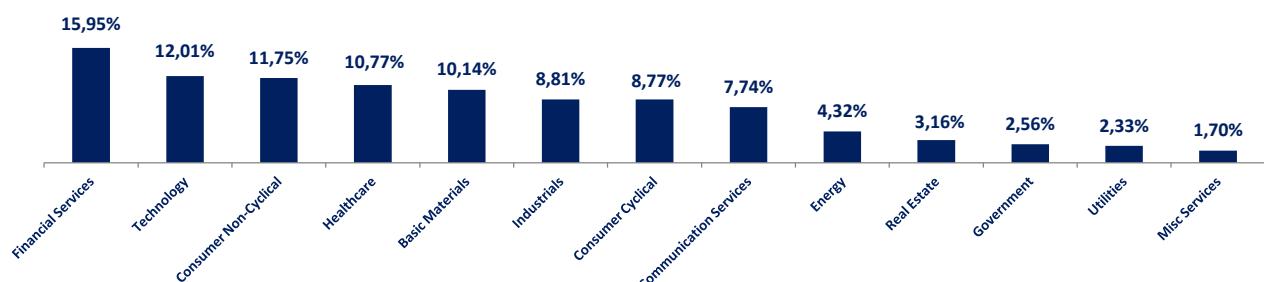
GEOGRAPHICAL ALLOCATION
