

Weekly Market Comment (by Dr. Mahnoosh Mirghaemi)

25-Jul-2021

Last week, was indeed a volatile week in markets. The week started with a "market sell-off" blast with a yield of 10-year Treasury hit as low as 1.12%. Eventually, the week ended with most major indices higher and S&P 500 closed on Friday at an all-time-high, despite kind of a disappointing U.S. data and the spread of the Delta variant.

U.S. futures won the most after about 87% of the S&P 500 companies' corporate earnings have beaten Wall Street estimates, according to Bloomberg data. The markets' pull back has been short-lived and infrequent, so far, due to the strong economic growth and investors' optimism. Investors are still not clear about Federal Reserve's timescale when it comes to its note about "transitory inflation". The risk remains with "lost in translation" between Fed and investors, as what may qualify as transitory for Fed will not necessarily be as fleeting for investors.

It seems that Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell faces an uphill challenge in securing a second term. "Given the central bank's significant regulatory and supervisory powers, left- leaning voices in the administration likely will not want a Republican like Powell to remain chair. We see a significant chance that Powell is not nominated to serve another four-year term as chair after his current term expires in January", according to note of Michael Feroli, J.P. Morgan chief U.S. economist.

Uncertainties around the pandemic, high expectations of growth and the probability of a shift in monetary policy, all together, can bring more noticeable equity market pull backs, in our view. So, what does inflation protection look like? A combination of consumer staples, utilities and large-cap tech companies seems to be the best hedge against inflation. The health care sector that benefited the most from the pandemic seems to be in danger, amid the delta variant and the sector's other businesses, such as operations, which are not directly related to the pandemic. Amongst these firms we can name, Fagron, Belgian pharmaceutical, Vifor Pharma, Swiss drugmaker and Hansa Biopharma of Sweden.

With regard to value and cyclical outperformance, in our view, all stars need to be aligned, i.e., yields must rise, economic growth should continue, governments should look beyond delta or any other variant, and central banks should continue their hawkish tone. According to a J.P. Morgan survey, "84% of investors expect the reflation trade to resume in the next few months and 57% plan to increase their equity exposure".

Overall, any great bull market has some draw-downs. As an example, the bull market running from 2009-2020, the second largest bull market on record, had six 10% corrections driven by various factors from oil price, trade war, Fed policy and growth concerns, according to Bloomberg data. Last week's market swing was just a reminder that volatility is there going to the 2H of this year and it is not only associated with equities but also with bonds.

Next week is all about the FOMC meeting and big-tech's earnings. Below is a schedule summary, with peak growth unknown:

- Monday: Tesla 2Q earnings
- Tuesday: Apple and Alphabet 2Q earnings, U.S. durable goods and Conf. Board consumer confidence
- Wednesday: Facebook 2Q earnings and FOMC rate decision, consumer confidence data from Germany, France and Italy
- > Thursday: Amazon 2Q earnings, Eurozone economic/consumer confidence, Germany CPI, and PPI in France and Italy
- > Friday: U.S. personal income/spending, Univ. of Michigan sentiment, MNI Chicago PMI,

Having all the above in our book, we prefer to hedge half of our exposure with still in favour of equities.

Oil's Brief

Oil prices changed a little, last week, amid optimism that demand will eventually rise and tighten the global market.

Russia is ready to ban the gasoline export as soon as next week, amid record high wholesale prices on the exchange.

Fossil fuel will be the key part of the India's energy mix, according to the nation's oil corp chairman.

Iran is ready to export its first batch of oil via Gulf of Oman instead of Strait of Hormuz.

Asia / EM Brief

Heavy rainfall and flooding in a major city of Henan province, a major transportation and logistics hubs, caused some agricultural and industrial production disruption.

Singapore is considering to impose either property gains tax or inheritance tax to combat the inequality.

Tokyo Summer Olympic started, while spectators are banned at events in Tokyo and around Tokyo.

Bank Indonesia left its interest rate unchanged, while downgraded its GDP growth from previous 4.1%-5.1% to 3.5%-4.3%.

Private Equity's Brief

Blackstone committed a record \$28 billion of its capital to the new deals in 2Q, due to mass of opportunities that pandemic created.

Leon Black, PE billionaire, admitted of having an affair with a former model from Russia, Guzel Ganiva, although he rejected assault allegations.

PE firms raised about \$459 billion in 1H, as healthy fund raising should continue through the year, according to the Bloomberg Intelligence analysts.

General Atlantic is trying to raise fund for investment in companies with strategy related to climate change i.e.decarbonization, energy efficiency, resource conservation and emissions management, according to the firm' statement.

U.S. investors poured record \$239 billion into the Vanguard S&P 500, this year. As ETFs are attracting more and more investors.





Canadian ETFs are among the most attractive ones, as investors are more eager about ESG factors.




Asset Allocation Calculator
